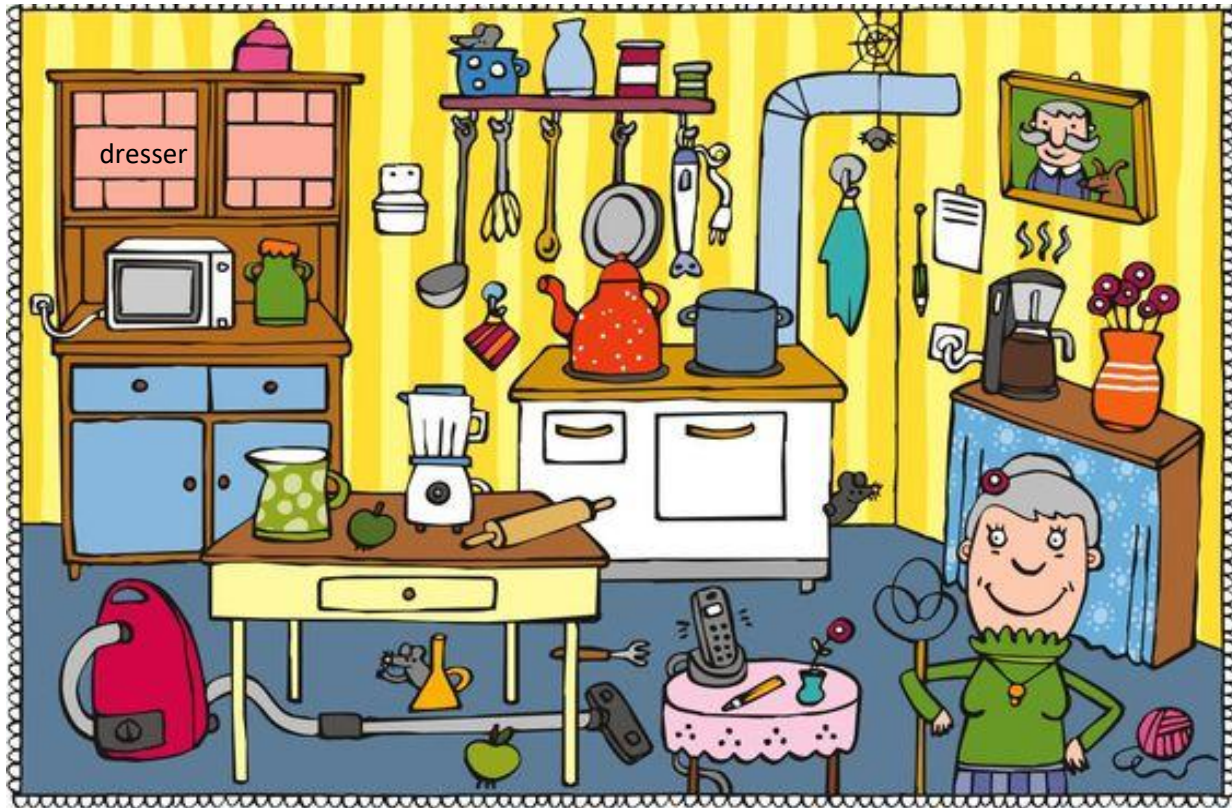


IN MARTHA'S KITCHEN
